Fitness for Duty & Practice

These high stakes evaluations include psychological, neuropsychological, psychiatric, neuropsychiatric, and occupational medicine assessments. They are specialized evaluations of professionals in safety-sensitive occupations, such as physicians, nurses or other healthcare professionals, airline pilots, air traffic controllers, law enforcement and emergency personnel, as well as professional drivers to determine their cognitive, emotional, and behavioural ability to carry out the duties of their profession.

Cognitive Screening & Competency Assessments

Cognitive Screening

We can conduct a brief and low-cost cognitive screening as an early alternative to full neuropsychological assessment, to provide preliminary answers and suggestions.

These screening assessments address concerns relating to cognitive abilities (including attention, concentration, memory, and processing speed) in various medical conditions, with a focus on a brain injury or concussion, as well as early signs of brain aging or decline. When required, we also screen for mental health issues, including depression and anxiety.
